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# ENGLISH LADIES' OPEN MID-AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP 2005

## 1. Qualifications

The English Ladies' Open Mid-Amateur Championship shall be open to female golfers who were 18 and under 50 years of age on the 1 January 2005; who are members of a recognised golf club; who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of the R&A Rules Limited; and who hold an CONGU Exact Handicap or overseas equivalent of not more than 9.4, at date of entry.

## 2. Regulations

- a) Entries shall be limited to 64. In the event of entries exceeding this number, the 64 players with the lowest Exact Handicaps will be accepted.  
In the event of a tie, the 64<sup>th</sup> place shall be decided by a ballot, which shall take place immediately after the closing date for entries. Those entrants balloted out will be placed on a waiting list. Unsuccessful entrants will have their Entry Fees refunded.
- b) Competitors shall enter through the Secretaries of their home clubs. Official entry forms must be used and may be obtained through the Tournament Secretary of the Association or downloaded from the ELGA website ([www.englishladiesgolf.org](http://www.englishladiesgolf.org)). Entries must reach the English Ladies' Golf Association, Edgbaston Golf Club, Church Road, Birmingham B15 3TB by 12 noon on the date on which the entries close. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- c) The Entry Fee must accompany the completed entry form. Cheques / Postal Orders should be made payable to ELGA. No entry will be included in the draw unless complete in every detail. Entry Fees will not be refunded after the closing date. Entries by fax, using the official Entry Form, will be accepted subject to payment of the Entry Fee within 7 days and prior to the closing date. Entries by telephone will not be accepted.
- d) All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Championship Committee of the Association, which shall have the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason for its decision, which shall be final.
- e) The Exact Handicap at the closing date will be used for the purposes of a ballot. IT IS VITAL YOU INFORM US IF YOU REDUCE YOUR HANDICAP AFTER YOU SEND IN YOUR ENTRY.
- f) The draw for partners will be done after registration has closed on the official practice day (Monday 8 August).
- g) Competitors must register IN PERSON at the ELGA Championship Office at the Golf Club no later than 3 p.m. on the day prior to the commencement of the Championship. Penalty for breach - DISQUALIFICATION. Telephone calls MAY be accepted in EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES. Please note - "Exceptional Circumstances" relate to breakdowns, or situations beyond your control that prevent you from fulfilling your intention to register in person.
- h) The ELGA will accept an entry form from a holder of a current CONGU Handicap or a ladies handicap awarded by a handicap authority other than CONGU and recognised by the English Ladies' Golf Association. Failure to produce proof of handicap by the time you return your scorecard after the first round will result in DISQUALIFICATION. A competitor so disqualified may act as a marker.
- i) The Committee reserves the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- j) In all matters, the decision of the Championship Committee is final.
- k) In the event of adverse conditions, the Committee reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.

## 3. Conditions

- a) The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and with Local Rules as may be approved by the Championship Committee.
- b) The Championship shall consist of two 18-hole qualifying rounds played on the first day, for which one draw will be made. The players returning the 32 lowest scores shall qualify for match play. The draw shall be made according to the automatic draw and shall be posted as soon as possible after termination of play.
- c) Ties for the last qualifying place(s) shall be decided by sudden death play-off over holes as decided by the Championship Committee.
- d) The ball the player uses must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A Rules Limited. Penalty for a breach is DISQUALIFICATION.
- e) DRIVING CLUBS - Driving clubs must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds when measured on pendulum testing apparatus approved by R&A Rules Limited - see also Appendix II, 5a of the Rules of Golf. Penalty for Breach of Condition - Disqualification.
- f) Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
- g) Players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless prior permission has been sought from the Championship Committee. Penalty for breach of condition; Stroke Play- TWO STROKES FOR EACH HOLE at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: FOUR STROKES.  
MATCH PLAY - LOSS OF EACH HOLE at which any breach occurred; maximum deduction per round: TWO HOLES.  
Match or Stroke Play - Use of any unauthorised vehicle shall be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach occurred. Otherwise, the player shall be DISQUALIFIED.
- h) If the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in stroke play and LOSS OF HOLE in match play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
- i) A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance her performance. Any competitor infringing this condition or, if asked to do so refusing to take a test, may be DISQUALIFIED.
- j) Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay. The pace of play procedure, detailing the Time Allowance, Procedure when groups are out of position, and the penalties for breach of condition, is clearly displayed on the Competitors notice board at the Championship.
- k) Motorised buggies may be utilised by Competitors who have sought permission from the Championship Committee before the Championship, on presentation of a current medical certificate of disability and then only if the host club permits the use of such buggies. The buggy may only be used by the person named on the certificate and may only carry the player, her caddie and equipment.
- l) Please note that, under the Rules of Amateur Status, a player's name should only appear on a bag tag or in small print on the golf bag itself. A player may be deemed to be advertising the manufacturer of that golf bag if her own name appears in large letters, which would constitute a breach of Amateur Status Rule 6-2 (Lending Name or Likeness).
